Numeracy Awards

Foundation

Reception – Number 10 badge: children must be able to recognise their numbers from 1-10, order them and count out a given number of objects to 10.

KS1

Year 1: Number bond badge: Children must be able to achieve all criteria for Number Ten badge and form all numbers 1-10 correctly and recall all number bonds to 10.

Year 2: Red Award: Children must recall the 2, 5 and 10 times tables' facts correctly on three consecutive occasions in 10 minutes or less.

KS2

Year 3- 6

Continue Red award as necessary.

Purple Award: 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables

Yellow Award: 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 10 times tables

Green Award: 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 times tables.

Blue Award: 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 times tables.

All of the above must be recorded correctly on three consecutive occasions in ten minutes or less.

Bronze Award - 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 times tables – 3 consecutive occasions in 7 minutes or less each time.

Silver Award - As Bronze, but in 5 minutes or less each time.

Gold Award As Bronze, but in 3 minutes or less each time.
