If they type 'Isle of Struay' into google (with adult supervision), there is a great powerpoint that shows first, linking the stories to the isle of coll, showing photos of the isle and asking lots of comparison questions which the parents could relate to Bristol. They could ask their child to consider 'Would you like to live on the Isle of Coll?' Why? Why not?'

Parents could also ask children to focus on reading, spellings and practising their tables.
