Here are some additional ideas for the children to continue learning at home, during the adverse weather conditions.

Science

Our new science topic is 'Solids, liquids and how they can be separated'. The children could list the solids and liquids found in the home and record them in a method of their choosing e.g. description or drawing. The snow and ice also provide you with the opportunity to discuss the changing state of materials.

English

The children could write a recount or diary entry of their Christmas holidays or what they have been getting up to during the snow days!

Please continue with reading and practising spellings. (New spelling sheets were given out at the end of last term).

Maths

Please continue to practise times tables, including related division facts. The children could also find two and three-dimensional shapes in the home and draw these, listing any properties they can think of.

If the children have had any board games with a hundred square for Christmas e.g. snakes and ladders they could play these and perhaps alter them to include maths questions.

Topic

The topic this term is The Romans. If possible the children could research an area of this topic.
