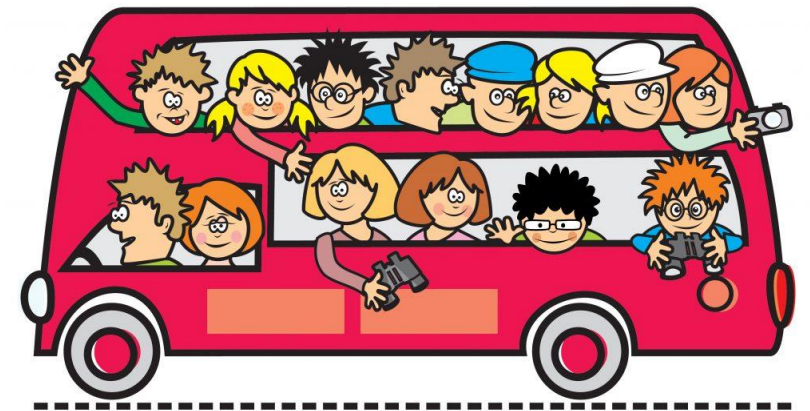

- Reading expectations

- Books checked weekly
 - Please ensure your child brings in their home learning book with their completed spellings inside on Thursdays
