Who are the Access and Response team in South Gloucestershire?

The Access and Response Team in South Gloucestershire is like your safety net outside of school hours. They're a group of experts trained to handle any worries you might have about your child's (or another child's) well-being when they're not in school. Whether it's concerns at home or in the community, 'ART' are there to take your call and listen to your concerns. 
