 We ask that children come to school in their full school uniform. Please refer to our school website for further information on this -



<u>English</u>

In English this term we will be looking at the picture book Star in the jar by Sam Hay. We will be exploring this story to practise our

writing skills such as using adverbs, noun phrases and using different prepositions to show position and direction.



<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this term we will develop our understanding of place value. We will be counting in 50's and 100's and representing numbers in different ways such as place values charts and dienes. We will also explore the place value of 3digit numbers.

Later in the term we will be focussing on addition and subtraction. We will be adding and subtracting ones to 3-digit numbers mentally and using our previous

Topic Subjects

Our Foundation Subject Topic this term is **'Walk like an Egyptian'** We will be learning all about the Ancient Egyptian period and investigating their advanced civilisation, the Gods they worshipped as well as the significant figures of that era. During our topic, we will be exploring the use of hieroglyphs, mummification and the rein of Tutankhamun. Within our STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) learning we will be focussing on the human body and online safety. This is the book children will be exploring during this topic. It has been carefully selected as a high quality text to support your child's learning of the curriculum. We invite children to read this book during their free-reading time in school but you may also want to grab a copy for your own bookshelves at home!

These will then be marked and returned to your child at the beginning of Term 2.
	We also ask that you read at least 5 times a week to develop your comprehension and fluency. In the coming weeks, we will be giving out login details for children to use on 'Purple Mash'. This is an online platform for those children who wish to practise their English and Maths even more at home! ⁽³⁾
