

- The Wright brothers, Orville and Wilbur, were two American brothers
- They invented and built the world's first successful airplane and made the first human flight on December 17. 1903.
- The brothers observed birds and how they angled their wings to balance and control the body when flying
- Orville piloted the first powered airplane 20 feet above in the beach of North Carolina. It lasted for 12 seconds and covered 120 feet.
