Years Five and Six will be visiting Carleon Roman Fortress on Friday 4th October 2024. The purpose of this trip is to enhance and extend our learning in our current history topic – The Romans.

In order to cover the cost of the trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £13.00 to be paid using the ParentPay platform. If you have any issues in funding this contribution, please speak to Mrs Flanagan or Mr Israel regarding this. There is no charge for children currently in receipt of Free School meals as the cost of this trip will be covered from the Pupil Premium allocation in the school budget. Please be aware that if contributions are significantly below the cost of the trip, then it may have to be cancelled and monies refunded.

We will leave school at 9:15am. We plan to return to school at approximately 3:15pm. If we expect to return later than this predicted time, we will send a text message to parents when we are on our journey back to advise you of a more accurate arrival time.

Children should wear school uniform, but as we will be walking around the Roman Fortress, they may wear trainers with their uniform.
