## Primary school admissions

If your child was born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022, you must apply for them to start primary school in September 2026. This is a very important decision and it is important that you read the South Gloucestershire Primary school admission quide before you apply. Applications for primary school admission must be submitted no later than 15 January 2026.
