English


In English this term, we will be looking at the text 'George and the Dragon', an exciting text

about a mighty dragon with an unusual fear! We will be focusing our learning on being able to use adjectives, similes and punctuation correctly.



Maths

In Maths this term we will be developing our understanding of place value. We will learn more about the place value of 2-digit numbers and using this knowledge to partition 2-digit numbers into tens and ones.



We will then learn how tens and ones can be represented in a variety of ways before moving on to develop our understanding of how to compare numbers

using <,> and =. We will also be ordering numbers from smallest to biggest and biggest to smallest, using our knowledge of place value to help us!




Topic Subjects

Our Foundation Subject Topic this term is 'Off With Her Head!' We will be learning all about the Tudor period in England from 1485 to 1603. During our topic, we will be finding out what life was like in Tudor times and even designing and building our own castles! Term 1 Reading Spine

This is the book children will be exploring during this topic. It has been carefully selected as a high quality text to support your child's learning of the curriculum. We invite children to read this book during their free-reading time in school but you may also want to grab a copy for your own bookshelves at home!







Your child will be taking part in P.E on **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. We are now able once again to use our cloakroom spaces. We will be asking for homework books to be brought back into school on Wednesday 20 th October. These will then be marked and returned to your child at the beginning of Term 2.
