(It will live in either the grass, soil, trees, under logs or stones)
- Its body parts
(insects have 6 legs, spiders have 8 legs, some have more legs (centipede), slugs and snails have a foot.
- what it eats
(some minibeasts feed off nectar, plants or other bugs)

- make a minibeast from junk materials

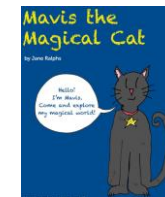


Writing
