Dear Parent/Carer,

Years Five and Six will be visiting Stonehenge on Wednesday 9th February 2022. The purpose of this trip is to enhance and extend our learning in our current history topic – From Foraging to Farming - which focuses on life in Britain during the Stone, Iron and Bronze Ages.

In order to cover the cost of the trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.50 to be paid using the ParentPay platform. If you have any issues in funding this contribution, please speak to Mrs Flanagan regarding this. There is no charge for children currently in receipt of Free School meals as the cost of this trip will be covered from the Pupil Premium allocation in the school budget. Please be aware that if contributions are significantly below the cost of the trip, then it may have to be cancelled and monies refunded.

We will leave school at 9am. We plan to return to school at approximately 4:15pm. If we expect to return later than this predicted time, we will send a text message to parents when we are on our journey back to advise you of a more accurate arrival time.

On this day, children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. Pupils who are in receipt of Free School Meals can be provided with a packed lunch from the school kitchen. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals and you require a school packed lunch to be provided, please make your child's teacher aware of this as soon as possible.

As the majority of this trip will take place outdoors please ensure that children have appropriate clothing – we suggest comfortable clothes (such as jogging bottoms/jeans and a jumper), a warm coat, gloves and hat and suitable footwear. We suggest comfortable shoes for walking that they do not mind getting muddy – trainers or walking boots/shoes are probably best.

There is a gift shop at Stonehenge which we plan to visit if time allows, so if you would like your child to bring money to spend in the gift shop they are welcome to. Please send up to £5 each in a labelled wallet or purse that they can carry as they will be responsible for their own money.
