### Safeguarding Corner

#### What is Body Safety?

Body safety means understanding that our bodies belong to us, and we have the right to feel safe and respected at all times. It's about knowing that nobody should touch us in a way that makes us uncomfortable, and if anyone does, we have the right to say no and seek help.

Top Tips for you to share with your children:

**Know Your Body:** Learn the correct names for your body parts, and understand that certain parts are private and should not be touched by others.

**Trust Your Feelings:** If something doesn't feel right or makes you uncomfortable, tell a trusted adult right away. Your feelings are important, and you have the right to speak up.

Safe Secrets vs. Unsafe Secrets: Remember that it's okay to have fun secrets with friends, but secrets that make you feel scared or uncomfortable are not okay. Always share those secrets with a trusted adult.


