I am able to express my appreciation for the people in my special relationships.

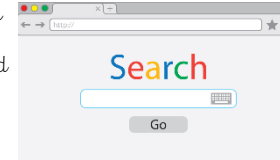


Cracking Contraptions Year 2 - Term 5



This term, we are learning how to retrieve relevant content using a search engine.

- Search engines are programs which help you to find pages on the internet.
- The internet is a network of computers that are connected together.
- The internet includes the World Wide Web, email, online gaming and messaging.
- We use a browser when we access the world wide web (often just called 'the web').
- A website URL is the specific address we can use to find a specific website.
- Within a website, there will be many webpages.
- The internet is an amazing resource to learn lots and connect with friends, however there are some dangers with it.
- I know that if I see something on the internet that I do not like or understand, or makes me feel uncomfortable, I should always tell an adult I trust.



VOCABULARY

Human features - features of land that have been impacted by human activity

Harbour - a sheltered port so that boats can be left there safely

Port - a harbour area where ships load and unload goods or passengers

Tourist - a person who is visiting a place for pleasure and interest

Town - a large group of houses, shops and buildings where people live and work. Towns are larger than villages but smaller than cities.

Village - a small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside. Coalpit Heath is a village.

Aircraft - an aeroplane, helicopter, or other machine capable of flight.

Aviation - The flying or operating of aircraft

Invent - create or design something that has not existed before

Relationship - the way 2 or more people behave towards one another.

Internet - A global computer network providing a variety of information and communication facilities.

Search - Look for information in a database or the World Wide Web using a search engine.

Search Engine - A program that searches for and identifies items on the World Wide Web.

Human Geography

- Human Geography explores how humans and their communities interact with the environment.
- If humans did not exist, these human features would not exist either.
- Our environment has changed over time because humans have built houses, villages, towns and cities.
- We have also used resources from the environment (such as wood from trees and coal from the ground).



Orville and Wilbur Wright

- The **Wright** brothers, **Orville** and **Wilbur**, were two American brothers.
- They invented and built the world's first successful airplane and made the first human flight on December 17, 1903.
- The brothers observed birds and how they angled their wings to balance and control the body when flying
- Orville piloted the first powered airplane 20 feet above in the beach of North Carolina. It lasted for 12 seconds and covered 120 feet.
