Exploring different emotions – introducing the Emotion Board in class starting with the Colour Monster book.

Knowledge of the world

Autumn, the seasons and months of the year, the past

Working scientifically we will be using observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions. We will observe changes across the season and observe and describe weather associated with the season.

What is a season? We will look at the different seasons and months of the year that fall into those seasons. **Is it Autumn everywhere in the world?** **What happens in nature during Autumn?** **Which animals prepare to hibernate?**

(Leaves fall off trees, plants stop growing and the days get darker. The weather turns colder and some animals hibernate. Hedgehogs make warm beds and sleep through the cold months, birds fly to warmer countries).

Exploring the difference in weather to somewhere very different ie Australia and comparing locations on maps.

Explore Remembrance Day and Bonfire night and discuss the events of the past which has led us to celebrations in the present.

Vocabulary: season, months, Autumn, light, dark, bright, reflect, shiny, moon, sun, flames, torches, electrical light sources, Guy Fawkes, in the past, a long time ago, the present, now.

- Begin to segment CVC words and write simple words.
- Orally rehearse a simple sentence.
