Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our 'Ship, Shape and Bristol Fashion' topic, we have planned a trip to STEAM Museum in Swindon on Friday 10th July 2026 for Year 3 and 4. This is a really exciting opportunity to explore our topic. During the visit, we will be attending the Railway Evolution workshops, where we will learn about the impact of the railway on the lives of the Victorian generation.

We will be leaving school by coach at around 9.15 am and will return approximately at 2:45 pm. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a non-fizzy drink. Pocket money will not be required. Pupils whose parents are in receipt of Free School Meals can be provided with a packed lunch from the school kitchen.
