**Should I keep my child off school?**

**Yes** Until...

- Diarrhoea** at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all stool have resolved
- Diarrhoea and Vomiting** 48 hours after their last episode
- Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)** they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19
- Measles** when they have started and finished or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
- Scarlet fever** 4 days after the rash first appeared
- Mumps** 5 days after the swelling started
- Singles** they've had their first treatment
- Scarlet fever** 24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
- Whooping Cough** 48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

**No** but make sure you let their school or nursery know if about...

- Head, face and mouth
- Strep throat
- Head lice
- Scabies

## Norovirus

There has been an increase in cases of Norovirus across the South West. We are following all guidance given by Health Protection Team, South West and UK Health Support Agency.

Norovirus is generally a self-limiting illness probably caused by a virus, but it is very infectious. The most usual symptom is vomiting. Some people may have diarrhoea and/or abdominal pain. Symptoms rarely last for more than 24 – 48 hours. The incubation period (time it takes for the illness to develop) is between 12 and 48 hours.

**If your child is affected, please keep them away from the setting. They should not return until 48 hours after the diarrhoea and vomiting have stopped.**

The virus is easily spread from person to person. Good hygiene by everyone in the family reduces the risk.
