Practice spelling words with the prefix 'dis' at the front of them. Think of creative ways to do this and send me some lovely pictures.

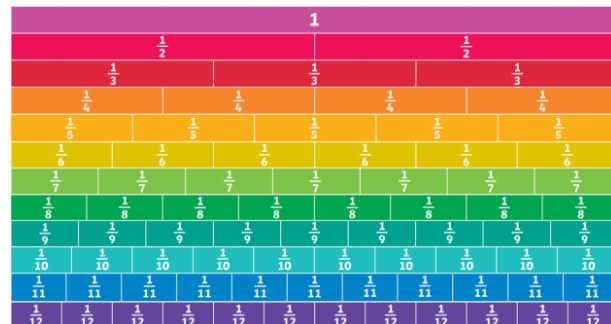
### Reading
