Apostrophes for possession.

In Year 3 we learn a lot about apostrophes and one of its uses is to show possession. For example:

Elly's cat is brown and fluffy. The girls' bathroom is flooded.

The apostrophe usually goes before the s however if there is more than one or the name ends in s then it will sit after the s. Such as:

Miss Hawkins' banana has gone mouldy.

### Maths

Money!!

This week we are going to look at money, particularly converting money.

Keywords: Converting – changing.  
Equal – the same as

We can convert pounds into pence and pence into pounds. The first thing you need to know is how many pennies are in a pound.... 100!

So 100p is equal to £1

£3 is equal to 300p.

Extra challenge:

345p is equal to £3.45

Tenths and Hundredths Place Value Grid

Thousands	Hundreds	Tens	Ones	Tenths	Hundredths

So when you convert from pence to pounds the numbers move 2 spaces to the right making the number 100 times smaller as you are dividing it by 100.

When you convert pounds to pence the number moves 2

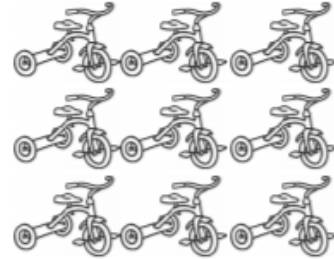
