Hello Asia class! This week sees the end of Term 5! So, instead of curriculum based activities below are some fun activities to do with your family during the break.

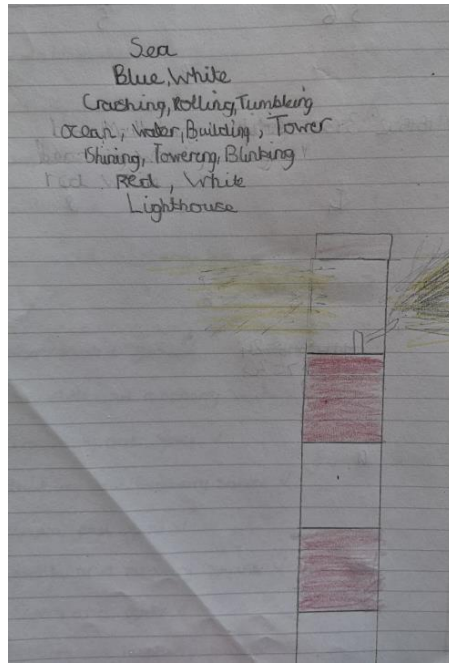
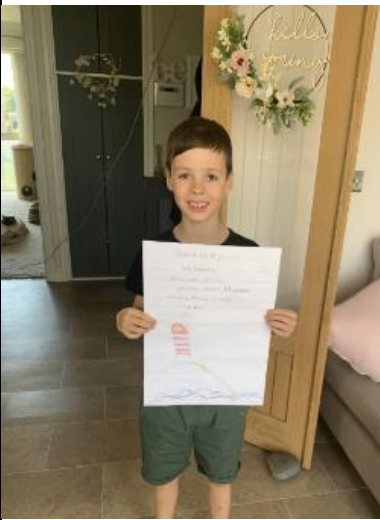
