Educational Visit to Windmill City Farm on Tuesday 31st March 2026

Dear Parents and Carers

We have booked a class trip to visit Windmill City Farm on Tuesday 31st March 2026. This will be a great way to see a variety of different farm animals, and meet the people who help run the farm. We will be leaving school in the morning and arriving back at school for the end of the school day.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch (and a non-fizzy drink) which we will eat at the farm. If you would like the school to provide your child with a packed lunch – please let the school office know as soon as possible. Pocket money will not be required for this trip.

In order to cover the cost of the trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.40 to cover the cost of the coach, entry to the farm and a guided tour and activities on the day. This is to be paid using the Parent Pay platform. Thank you to FOMS for their contribution to this trip which has meant that the cost is lower than it would have been otherwise. If you have any issues in funding this contribution, please speak to Mr Israel. There is no charge for children currently in receipt of benefits related Free School Meals as the cost of these children will be covered from the Pupil Premium allocation in the school budget.

If the voluntary contributions are significantly below the cost of the trip then it may have to be cancelled and monies refunded.

On the day of the trip, the children will need to come dressed in their school uniforms and be equipped for the weather and the environment. We will change into our wellies and (if necessary) Forest School waterproofs before leaving so please make sure your child's forest school kit is in school.

We do require some parent helpers to accompany us on this trip. If you are able to do this, please email us on our class email; antarcticaclass@sgmail.org.uk We will then contact you to confirm if we need your help. If we receive lots of offers of help, we will select names randomly.
