- I am happy to try new things and stay cheerful when things don't go my way.
- I will try for myself before I ask for help.
- I know it is okay to make mistakes and am happy to try again.
- I can use different strategies to help myself when I get stuck.

- I will choose tasks that provide me with a suitable challenge to help me improve.
